Types and Symbols: What's the difference?

In the Bible Paul gives us an important principle to work from, namely, that there is “*first the natural and then the spiritual*” (1 Cor 15: 46).

This principle is a well-known one in both the Teaching and Prophetic circles, as it forms a good New Testament basis for understanding the symbolic language of Scripture.

It's as if the Lord has given us created things to show forth a spiritual truth. This can only be understood and appreciated when we begin to dig out the treasures of the Word. The so-called language of Creation becomes to us the language of Spiritual Insight.

We need to be cautious in the use of Biblical texts, and by the Holy Spirit, seek His revelation knowledge on what a particular verse might mean. There is a need to clarify what is a symbol and what is a Biblical type.

SYMBOLS in the Bible are used as **representations**, that is, what is an actual real object has in it some characteristic that tells us of a deeper truth. Note the case of the seven stars and the seven candlesticks in Rev 1: 20.

These stars give off light, they are in the heavenlies, they are seen (in the night) and then (in the day) they are invisible. These are good **symbols** of angels, who have these same characteristics.

One of the ways to determine whether something is a symbol or not is to ask, “Does this text make literal sense?”. If not, it is usually symbolic.

I have found that usually it is the Bible that interprets its own symbols. You can see this in the Parables of Jesus where He often explained the meaning of them and gave a symbolic interpretation. Therefore a close study of the Word will give you a good overview of how symbols are used there. Don't be tempted to add your own unique meaning to a symbolic text or you will force Scripture to say something that was never intended.

What then is a **TYPE**? The word “type” comes from the New Testament Greek *TUPOS*, which means “*to impress an image; to model or pattern; to stamp as using a die*”.

A type is also a representation similar to a symbol, but with one important difference. In typology the type stands for a **PROPHETIC** interpretation. It pre-figures something else.

Basically, a type usually always is future in tense. In other words, a symbol can give us insight to some action in the past, present or future, but a type normally tells of some future (prophetic) event or meaning. It speaks of something or someone yet to come, from the vantage of the time in which the type was first given.

For example: the **RAINBOW** (Gen. 9: 13-16) is a **symbol** not a type. However the man **ADAM** is a **type** of those who were yet to come after him.

There is however an added insight to all this which is vital to appreciate. In the study of Scripture there is a “correctness” that is normally used to interpret the meaning of the Word of God. You may be familiar with the phrase “a text without a context is a pretext”!

Biblical scholars will usually say that the Scriptures must always be understood in terms of its context. That is, when studying the Word we should read what goes before and after the text we are studying. This way there is less chance of erroneous interpretation as the verse is “in context”. Most students of the Word, especially Pastors and Teachers use this method.

Generally it’s OK, but is it the whole story when it comes to a prophetic understanding of Scripture? I don’t think so. When we deal with prophetic insights we need to learn to go by the leading of the Holy Spirit. I know this opens up a minefield, and I can hear the cry of “danger” from all around. Nevertheless it would be great presumption to think we know all there is to know about typology or symbolism in the Word.

Cannot the Spirit give us fresh understanding for this hour? I’m not talking about changing doctrine here or saying we should re-interpret the Word to backup some “new teaching”. I am speaking of being open to prophetic revelations that are contained in the Word, but which due to our tradition, teaching or experience have stopped us from consideration of even richer insights.

For this reason, even though I have tried to explain the difference between Symbol and Type, I find there is considerable overlap in the understanding of both.

I will ask you to use your discernment in judging what is to be considered a Symbol or a Type, particularly in its prophetic meaning.

I hope this manual will help those in the prophetic, as well as those who attempt to understand what a dream or vision might mean. However the interpretations of Types and Symbols here are not meant to be definitive in any way.

A reliance on the Holy Spirit to speak **His** interpretation is vital. Yet the warning is still there; do not force the meaning of a word to mean something that is obviously out of flavour with what Scripture clearly says.

May the Lord give us wisdom and understanding in the matter.

Postscript to the 2007 edition:

Since the first edition of this booklet in 1997 I have added many other insights that has resulted in a 50% increase in the size of this publication. Included are the meanings of the Hebrew alphabet, months of the year and meaning of the 12 sons of Jacob and 12 Tribes of Israel. I have found that many people are still hungering for understanding in these areas. If you are one, then I pray and hope that you will continue to seek the wisdom of the Holy Spirit in your reading and application of these “types and shadows”.

METALS, MINERALS and STONES

ALABASTER	Grace; preciousness; value.
BRASS	Judgment against sin; endurance and the strength that goes with it; disobedience.
BRICK	Man-made religiosity; false religion.
BRIMSTONE	Judgment from God.
BRONZE	Needing refinement (note that Bronze is a combination of metals and therefore not pure).
CLAY	Frailty of human flesh; the weakness of character.
COAL	Evil words that burn; defiled by sin; purging.
COPPER	See " <i>Brass</i> ".
DUST	Frailty of human nature; reproduction of Mankind in the natural sense; humiliation and shame; a witness against disbelief, sin or apathy.

BLUE	Heavenly origin; perfection; divinity; heavenly character; forgiveness; a reminder to obey the heavenly message, hence the Blue on the Israeli flag and Jewish prayer shawl.
CARMEL <i>or</i> CRIMSON	Blood of Christ; atonement; sacrifice.
CRIMSON	Blood atonement; sacrifice; thorough and permanent.
GOLD	Deity; divine righteousness; kingship.
GREEN	Godly counsel; prosperity; growth; enrichment; life; zeal; perpetuity; testimony; eternal praise. Can also mean hypocrisy.
GREY	Dignity; honour of old age; wisdom.
PALE	Death and disease.
PRIMAL COLOURS	The Godhead bodily (Golden yellow / Crimson red / Heavenly blue).
PURPLE	Royalty; kingly dignity on earth; Sonship; the royal seed; a mediator (purple is a mixture of blue and red, which speaks of divinity and blood); prosperity.
RED	Bloodshed in war; suffering; sin; sacrifice; judgment.
RED HEIFER	Perfect consecration.
RIBBAND <i>blue hem</i>	Reminder of God's covenant laws.
SAFFRON	Consuming fire of God.

COLOURS continued

SCARLET	Death to self; humanity; especially of Jesus; sacrifice.
SEQUENCE OF COLOURS	Blue / Purple / Scarlet, always in this sequence. Purple is always the harmonising colour; being the one colour that brings the other two (blue and scarlet) together.
SILVER	Redemption; work of Atonement; the price of a soul.
WHITE	Pure; sinless character; a righteous walk; holiness.
WHITE <i>Linen</i>	Spotless purity.
WHITE <i>Robes</i>	Purity and priestly service.
BLACK HORSE	Famine.
PALE HORSE	Death and Hades; pestilence.
RED HORSE	War and the sword.
WHITE HORSE	Conqueror and victory; the Word of God; spiritual revival.

ASH TREE	Works that are idolised.
BRAMBLE	Smallness of influence; forsaken.
BRANCHES	The Ecclesia; the saints in a collective sense.
BRIAR BUSH	Curse; false teaching; punishment.
BAY TREE	The prosperous sinner.
BUSH	Meekness compared to greatness.
CASSIA	The fragrance of Christ; worship.
CEDAR or <i>Cypress</i>	Saints of God; the “royal” tree of the north, Lebanon; building up of the Body; habitation of the Holy Spirit; also the Pride of those who stand against God.
FIG <i>Tree</i>	Israel, particularly in a political sense (see also <i>Olive Tree</i>); prosperity; fruitfulness; restoration.
FIG <i>Leaves</i>	Man’s attempt at righteousness.
FOREST	Symbol of the gentile nations.
FIR or <i>Box</i> or <i>Pine</i>	To beautify; adorn; the finest; greatness, stateliness.
GROVE of <i>trees</i>	To group together, usually for immoral or evil purposes.
GOODLY TREES	Fruitful in the right season.
JUNIPER	A defeated soul or spirit; disappointment in life; defeat.

LEAFY TREES	Life; health and strength from the Lord.
MUSTARD TREE	The Ecclesia; many from one (<i>the Seed</i>); faith.
MYRTLE	Evergreen; everlasting works; beauty; God's blessings.
OLIVE TREE	Israel, in a religious sense (compare <i>Fig Tree</i>); anointing.
OAK	Impending, approaching death; strength.
ORCHARD	The delight of God's people in unity; great fruitfulness.
PALM TREE	Supply; prosper; victory; righteousness; joy; uprightness; fruitfulness; the "royal" tree.
PALMS <i>Seventy</i>	The 70 disciples; 70 gentile nations.
PINE	A Christian who has a useful life; beauty; fragrance.
POMEGRANATE	Joy and fruitfulness; fruit of the Spirit; great multiplication.
SHITTAH <i>or Acacia</i>	To serve the Lord; humanity.
SHITTIM WOOD	Humanity of Jesus; to sojourn (as Christ did in His humanity).
TREE OF LIFE	Pattern for complete fruitfulness; maturity of spirit and soul; wholeness; eternal life.
TREES <i>in general</i>	Trees are spiritual gateways into higher realms of divine understanding; points of entry. Trees are also believers, nations, peoples, especially Gentiles.
TREES <i>cut down remaining</i>	Judgment. Blessing and provision.
VINE	Jesus Christ; central as like a "shaft".
WILLOW	Pliable, yielded to the Water (the Word); sometimes standing for sorrow; weeping.
WOOD	Mankind.

ALMOND	To be on watch; fruitfulness.
ALMOND BUD	Resurrection; spiritual watching.
ALMOND FRUIT	The Spirit; fruitfulness.

BALM	Healing.
BARLEY	Passover harvest; lowliness; poverty.
BLOSSOM	Beauty and fragrance (note the process from bud to bloom to fruit); fruit to follow; hope of a bountiful harvest.
BOUGH	Servanthood; effects of a good life influencing others.
BRAMBLE	Selfishness; no fruit as result; curse.
BRANCH	The extended grace of Jesus' flourishing.
